Board of Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrmn. Dennis Abbott, Robert Fay, (Andrew Woddsome, Jr. absent due to illness), Jean Chick, Glenn Bean, Sr. Rd. Comm., Mark Caldwell, Assessor.

7:00 PM: Hearing held for issuance of Liqour License for Roge's Restaurant, owner Roger Wilson. License granted.

Mark Caldwell : Mark met with the Board to discuss the State Valuation of the Town. After discussion it was decided that Mark touch bases with State representative Mike Rogers regarding the State's Values and do a study and then make a decision on whether or not the Town should appeal the State's Assessment. The States's value is up 10% over last year's value.

Discussion was also held with Caldwell on the real estate taxing of YWCA property on Ossipee Lake, the former Camp Laughing Loon. Caldwell said he would check and see if the Town could tax this property, as the YWCA is renting the property out to private citizens and groups.




