February 25, 1986
Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrmn. Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Robert Fay, Jean Chick.

James Hamilton: Mr. Hamilton was in to discuss the Hamilton Road drainage problem, Hamilton said that it appears that all the abutters are ready to get going on the Project. He said they are going in the direction that Town Engineer Walt Stinson suggests. There seems to be a mutual agreement with the landowners. Hamilton said that he had talked to the State Highway Dept. and that he feels the State will enlarge the culvert out on Route 202 to direct the water over to the West Road to Brock's Brook. The Board agreed that before any work could be done an easement would have to be signed by the landowners. Hamilton said that he would write something up but would need the width needed for the easement. The Town's Engineer will be asked to provide this information. Hamilton said that he would be away for at least three weeks, Abbott said that when Hamilton got the easement written up come in to the office and discuss the matter with the Board and the other landowners.

SAD #57: The Town of Waterboro has been making the payments to the school on the fourth Tuesday of each month. Charles Doane called the office and requested that the school be sent the check before the 20th of each month, this would cover the State Law. The Board voted unanimous to pay the school each third Tuesday.

Computer Center: Mr. Lee Clarke of the Computer Center will be called and asked to attend the Town's Annual Town Meeting on March 8th. to speak to the citizens about Computers. An Article is on the Town Meeting Warrant asking the citizens to vote to raise money to purchase a computer for the Town Office.

Town Property: During the week a Merle Ring of the Forestry Dept. checked at the Office concerning the pruning and cutting of trees on the Town's property. The Town will be allowed a reimbursement from the State for work that is completed. Selectman Woodsome said that he had talked with Conservation Commission Member Dan Langill about this matter and that this should be put on hold until Langill got back to the Board.

Ballot Counters: Town Clerk Dianne Holden had asked the Board if they wanted counters to come in Town Meeting night at 8:00 PM and let the Ballot Clerks leave. The Board voted to have the counters come in.


