Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrmn. Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Jean Chick

National Guards: The East Waterboro Elementary School will be called as asked if the Town can use the showers from June 13 to June 27 for fifteen men that will be in town crushing gravel at the Town Pit. The Guards will do the work free but will need showers and also are requesting insurance coverage. Batchelder Bros, will be called for a Certificate of Insurance.

Cole Assoc.: Pres. Thomas Cole submitted a letter to the Board of Selectmen dated 2/28/86 that all bids on record be withdrawn. He wishes to be informed when the land at Lake Arrowhead Ests. is available to be bid on. At this present time all Town owned lots at LAE are tied up in a civil action at Superior Court.

Mr. & Mrs. James McFarland: The McFarland's are in the process of building a new home on the Thyng's Mills Rd. they are concerned about the SAD #57 school bus picking children up on this road as it is a dirt road and the McFarland's were under the impression that school buses could not run over dirt roads. Selectmen were not aware of this being the case. The Selectmen told McFarland that the Town receives from the SAD #57 Transportation Coordinator a list of needed school bus turn arounds. The Town then sees that these turnarounds are made.

Road Signs: A letter will go out to the Dept. of Transportation on a request received in this office from So. Maine Finishing Corp. for a "35 MPH" sign by the curve near the plant and also "Trucks Entering" sign by the plant.

Annual Town Mtg: Ed Waterhouse will be hired to set up the Elementary school for Town Meeting. The Selectmen will meet here at the Office at 7:00 PM on Friday March 7th. go to the school and check it out and also transport any equipment and paperwork to the school.

Roger Thyng: Eugene Durgin Thyng's employer came with him to talk to the Board about Thyng's back real estate taxes. Thyng owes taxes from 1979 ; 80; 81; 82; 83; 84 & 85. Chrmn. Abbott explained that in the past the Board had made an agreement with Thyng to make payments on the back taxes and Thyng had never followed through on them. Selectman Fay said that he had visited Thyng at his house concerning payment on the back taxes. Durgin said that he would make sure that Thyng paid at least \$100. per month. The Board agreed to this but Abbott made it very clear to Roger that he must still continue the payments after the August auction of tax title property.

Water Tests: The Board will have Mr. Dennett of Peck Lab test the

well water at Robert Ramsell's property and Barlett Pond by EPA protocol. Well water at Edna Roberts, Bud Knight, Brian Whitten, Cook's Brook at Rte. 202 & 4 and Cook's Brook at Jellerson Road for heavy metals. Conservation Commission Member Neil Raymond was called and informed of this and that the money would be taken from the Water Test Account. Debra Downs Chairman of the Commission was called but was not at home. Mr. Raymond agreed with the Board's decision.

Public Hearing: Peppercorn Restaurant Liquor license hearing will be held March 25th.

Town Maps: Town Engineer Walt Stinson's office to be called and will order sets of the small Town Tax Maps plus a large Zoning Map for the Board of Selectmen's Office.
