

## MINUTES

March 11, 1986

### Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrnm. Dennis Abbott, Robert Fay, Jean Chick. (Andrew Woodsome, Jr. on vacation in Florida)

Chairman: A new Chairman of the Board of Selectmen will be elected after Mr. Woodsome returns from vacation. Dennis Abbott will remain Chairman until that time.

Winter Roads Foreman: Selectman Fay moved that the newly elected Road Commissioner, Fred Fay be appointed as Winter Roads Foreman, Seconded by Chairman Abbott.

Water Testing: Bob Dennett of Peck Lab had called the office this morning requesting that Dennis Abbott call him and set up a time and date that the well water and Barlette Brook and Cook's Brook could be tested. Dennett would like to do the testing on the weekend while the property owners are more likely to be at home. Neil Raymond a member of the Conservation Commission was called and Mr. Raymond said that he would go with Mr. Dennett to do the testing. A meeting date and time will be set up through the office and Mr. Raymond will be notified.

Fred Dezan: Mr. Dezan called the office today to inquire about an outstanding 1983 real estate tax on a trailer he owned in 1983 located at the Twin Pines Trailer Park in No. Waterboro, the trailer was sold in 1983. The Board agreed to abate the \$44.75 tax.

Richard Harnett: Mr. Harnett met with the Board to discuss his mail box that was knocked down by a truck while the Bagley Road was being maintained. At this time the Selectmen had planned a meeting with the newly elected Road Commissioner Fred Fay and the snowplowing contractor's. Mr. Fay, Dwayne Woodsome, Robert Abbott and former Road Commissioner Glenn Bean, Sr. was in attendance .

Contracter Robert Abbott was asked if he had hit Mr. Harnett's mailbox while plowing. Abbott said he did not hit any mail box. Glenn Bean said that he had been notified about the situation, had talked with Dwayne Woodsome and that Dwayne had said that he would replace the mailbox, however, that Dwayne had since changed his mind.

Selectman Fay said the Town hired contractor's, they carry liability insurance and that it was between the contractor and Mr. Harnett, maybe a civil matter, but that he may be wrong on that.

Mr. Harnett said that the mailbox was a minor thing, the issue is that when the road is slippery it needs to be sanded and that he had no problem with the sanding truck turning in his driveway. The only thing he wanted is a mailbox replaced that was knocked down that was on his property and not on the Town's property. Harnett said he would go along with a mailbox in a pail of sand for the remainder of the winter and would place it permanent in the Summer.

Dwayne Woodsome said that he agreed with Mr. Harnett's story on what happened and that if Harnett had not run off at the mouth he would have replaced the mailbox.

It was the Board's decision that the Town's Attorney Roger Elliott be called in the morning and get his opinion on who is responsible for replacing the mailbox.



At this time snowplowing contractor Douglas Foglio jointed the meeting. The new Road Commissioner Fred Fay said that he was not hard to get along with and that he would like everyone's cooperation and that he would also be cooperative. The vandalism at the Town Dump and Stump Dump was discussed, the gate has been broken again and Stony's little camp broken into and his TV set stolen. Dwayne Woodsome said that there is a large rock on the Roberts Ridge Rd that should be removed, Bob Abbott said that there are two on the Clapper Hill and aslo one on the Webber road that needs to be removed as the plow blades are hitting them.

The new sanders that are to be purchased were discussed, Selectman Fay said it was up to Fred to come in with prices.

A new salt shed to be located on Town property by the Transfer Station was discussed.
