March 18, 1986

Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrmn. Dennis Abbott, Robert Fay, Jean Chick (Andrew Woodsome, Jr. absent)

Batchelder Bros, Ins. Co.: Chrmn. Abbott said that he had received a call from Alden Thayer concerning the Town's coverage. Can not get the million dollar coverage, first Commercial Union said they would write it and the market changed and will not be able to. Mr. Thayer will keep trying and he mentioned to Abbott that under the State of Maine Tort Claims Act the Town did not need more than the \$300,000. on liability coverage.
MAine Municipal Assoc. will be called for an opinion on the \$300,000. liability coverage.

SAD #57, Director's : Carmine Castado, Judy Carll and Brenda Charland were asked to meet with the Board to review the SAD #57 1986-87 Budget. Chrmn. Abbott had some concerns on the stated effects on local tax assessments. He wanted to talk to the Director's on the effect the \$125,000. increase would have on the Town of Waterboro's tax rate. Abbott said that putting every thing together he felt the tax rate would increase by one dollar, giving the fact that the Town at the Annual Town Meeting did not raise through Taxation anymore this year than last, and that a lot of the funds would be taken from the unappropriated Surplus, therefore, the school payment would raise the tax rate. Abbott said that he would like to see the line item balances as of March 31st.

It was discussed that the Selectmen and the Waterboro Director's should go on Cable TV and present the proposed budget and perhaps this could even be done on the hearing night with Supt. Gallucci and Bus. Manager Doane. This will be set up when the dates are set for the hearings.

Roads: Rd. Comm. Fred Fay said that he had had some contacts from companies interested in the seal coating bid. Selectman Fay called and asked that Frank Scott submit to the Town a detailed report on what roads were sealed last year and the milage of each, in 1985.

Doomsday, So called: To be held on April 5th. from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The Selectmen will request that Mark Caldwell be available to meet with any citizens interested in reviewing there property assessments.




Mr. Dennett will meet Conservation Commission member Neil Raymond here at the office and will do the testing on Saturday, March 22nd. at 10:00 AM.

Computer Seminar: Dianne Holden, Margaret Beavis and Jean Chick will attend a Computer Seminar in Augusta on March 27th.
