Selectmen's Meeting

Cold Mix Bids: Bids were opened by Selectman Abbott. Bids received from Eastern Bituminous, Commercial Paving and Blue Rock Industries. The Selectmen tabled the bids. The Board will meet with the Road Commissioner April 22nd. to make the decision on the Cold Mix Bids and the Seal coat Tar bids.

Computer Selection Committee: Selectman Abbott met with David Buck, Margaret Beavis, Dianne Holden and Jean Chick. James Caril and Donald Turner, Jr. did not attend the meeting. Copies are to be made and distributed to the members of all materials available at the office concerning computers. The Committee will meet again on April 17th. at 7:30 PM. The Committee will plan to meet on the 1st & 3rd. Thursdays.

LeChef Caterer: Ron Berthiaume in to discuss his request to have a one day liquor license signed by the Board in order for him to sell liquor at a Wedding reception being held in the Town Hall April 19th. The Board had informed the party renting the hall that this would not be allowed. Mr. Berthiaume said that he had liability insurance and he would not be serving liquor to minors or to anyone intoxicated for fear of losing his license. Selectman Abbott that the Board does not knowingly and willingly allow liquor in the Hall. The Board decided that MMA would be called and questioned on the Town's liability.

Roads: Evergreen Drive: According to the Plan of Northwood Village, by Stanley Harmon, Harmony Homes a drainage easement was laid out between lots 4 & 5 in actuality this was never done. Mr. Harmon will receive a letter from the C.E.O. requesting that he correct this. Rd. Comm. Fay said that he had gone up to check the problem out and he felt that if the owners of lots 4 & 5 built up their lawns the water would run down off the road and stop the erosion on Evergreen Drive.

Bagley Road: Rd. Comm. Fay said that about 1,500 to 2,000 feet of the road needed gravel. Fay said that the owners of one of the Crabtree Acres lots can not get to their lot and the CMP trucks can not get up in to place the poles. At this time Doug Foglio, Sr. Chairman of the Town's Road Review Committee jointed the meeting. The Board asked that he get his members to do an onsite inspection of the Road and present a plan to the Board on work that was needed. The Committee will meet at the corner of the Bagley Road and Route 5 at 5:00 PM, Monday April 14th.

New Road: Rd. Comm. Fay said that the dirt section of the New Road had been graveled. Chrmn. Woodsome made the motion that the Board send the Board of Selectmen in the Town of Alfred informing them that the Town had spent money on gravel and that they would like to see the Town of Alfred tar this section of road to solve any problems the Town's have had in the past .




