Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Fred Fay, Jean Chick

Peter Harriman: Harriman in to discuss Lot 1495 at Lake Arrowhead Estates. Harriman purchased this lot from the Town. Harriman's Attorney James Shirley said that he felt that this lot should be on the Swap Pool listing as this lot was swapped for another lot. Information concerning how the Town acquired this lot, etc. will be forwarded to Atty. Elliott and he is to review the material and confer with Atty. Shirley and if necessary ask Atty. David Fisher to sign a deed giving the Town all rights to this lot.

Water Tests: Selectmen have received input from several citizens concerning the water tests done on Cook's Brook. The Board voted to have Peck Lab do more testing in the area. The mill pond by Edith Hughey's is to be checked out, water hole which is a runoff from Cook's Brook in back of Forest Abbott Jr.'s., and also just before Cook's Brook meets Bartlett Pond. Timothy Nelson the Town's Health Officer will go with Mr. Dennett from Peck Lab when the tests are done.

Seal Coat & Tar Bids: Selectman Abbott moved that the bid from Eastern Bituminous be accepted, seconded by Selectman Fay.

Cold Mix Bids: Selectman Abbott moved that the bid from Eastern Bituminous be tentatively accepted and before final acceptance have their representative meet with the Board to discuss the bid. Selectman Fay seconded.


Timothy Nelson: Nelson reviewed the areas that the Board wishes to have water tests done. He will go with Mr. Dennett when the tests are taken.
