Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chrmn. Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Fred Fay, Rd. Comm., Jean Chick.

MMA: Chrmn. Woodsome said that he had received a phone call from MMA notifying him that he had been chosen to be on a Committee regarding the DEP having to notify the Municipalities when they are checking within the Municipality for pollution of water and etc. Woodsome said that this appointment came about because of the Bill that Rep. Lord submitted at last Legislation.

Northwood Village: Rd. Comm. Fay and CEO. Foglio said that Stanley Harmon the Developer had been made aware of the drainage problem in the development and that he would meet with the Board. Rd. Comm. Fay will call Harmon and set up an appointment.

Cold Mix Bids: Eastern Bituminous Bid was accepted by the Board. Chrmn. Woodsome made the motion, seconded by Selectman Fay that the Board will leave it up to Road Commissioner Fred Fay as to what mix he wants. A letter will go out to Eastern notifying them that they were awarded the bid and that they are to contact Fred Fay prior to mixing.

Health Officer: Motion made by Chr. Woodsome and passed unanimous that Tim Nelson, Health Officer receive \$6.90 per hour as does the C.E.O.

Roads: The Board and Road Commissioner discussed the roads in general. Rd. Comm. Fay said that he had received a price on a sweeper. Doug Foglio offered his wind row for \$25.00 per hour, this piece of equipment has a 7 foot scraper. Fay said that he could use this in some of the development.

Atty. Elliott: Chrmn. Woodsome will call Elliott tomorrow and inquire how the deposition went with Lewis, Penna & Giandria of the Northern Land Bank this morning in Elliott's office. Also he will inquire of the lot 1495 status .
