July 8, 1986

Board of Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Chairman Andrew Woodsome, Jr. , Robert Fay, Jean Chick.  
(Selectman Dennis Abbott, out of town on business) Fred Fay, Rd. Comm.

Rudy Ross, Parks & Rec. Comm: Only member present for a meeting with the Board and the Fish & Game Dept. No one was present from the Fish & Game Dept.

Mr. Ross picked up copies of the map of Route 5 picnic area for the Parks & Rec. Comm. Discussion was held on the use of the swimming area being used by boaters to launch their boats. Selectman Fay said that perhaps the Constables should be used on weekends at the area. Also that perhaps some signs designating the areas should be placed. Mr. Ross said that the Parks & Rec. would hold Old Home Days on July 26th. at the High School.

Charles Drapeau, Fire Chief: In to talk with the Board concerning the town map the Department had printed. It appears that some of the road names do not correspond with the town road names. He was told that in order to change a name of a town road it would have to be done by a vote at Town Meeting.

John Alfano: In to pick up a letter signed by Chairman Woodsome stating that he gave the Town of Waterboro \$16,500. to be used on the construction of the roads in Westwinds Subdivision. Road Commissioner Fay said that the brush was being cut along the road way and if Alfano planned on changing the cul-de-sac and have it located down over the hill that he should talk to Doug Foglio.

Joseph Guimond: Mr. Guimond has been working for the Town at the Town Dump guarding the National Guard equipment and also tending the Stump Dump area. Guimond met with the Board tonight to be interviewed for the permanent job of Stump Dump Attendant. One other applicant Howard Hammond of Lyman did not show up for his interview. Selectman Fay made the motion to hire Mr. Guimond and Chrmn. Woodsome seconded. It was mentioned that once Rd. Comm. Fay had the fence erected in front of the Dump the guard duty would cease.


Mark Caldwell: Mark said that he had visited Northern Data and talked with them about the computer the Town is purchasing in regards to the factoring up of the valuations. Mark plans to factor up by Map to level wanted.

Mark said from the period of April 1985 to April 1986 the Village average ratio was 68%; Rural area average ratio 65%, Subdivisions are average ratio of 73%; Lake Arrowhead average ratio 73%, Ossipee - ake is average ratio of 68%.

Mark said that by the end of the month the tax information would be put on computer and that he could factor up this year to 80% . Chrmn. Woodsome will call the newspapers and give them a newsrelease concerning the ratio increase, Caldwell will submit the information for Woodsome to use.

Li'l Al's Pizza Barn: On May 6th. the Board sign a Malt and Vinous license on this license there is a stipulation that Mr. Berube the owner erect a stockade fence between his property and the Earl's, within 90 days. The 90 day period ended today and the fence is not up. The Board will write Mr. Berube a letter giving him two weeks to comply to avoid revoking his license.
