Board of Selectmen's Meeting

Stump Dump: Voted to remind Fred Fay that the Board had agreed to rent a privy from him for the Stump Dump Area.

Voted to get a price on a building for shelter for the Stump Dump Attendant from Contractor's Timothy Nelson and Ernest Cragin.

Lot 939: Herbery Hoffman is interested in purchasing this lot. Atty. Elliott will be called tomorrow and asked his opinion on the status of the Lot. Whether it belongs to the Town if it should still be part of the Swap Pool Lots, as it is mentioned in paragraph 3 on Page 3 of the Agreement between the Town, First National Bank of Boston and GAI.

Special Town Meeting: Atty. Tom Coward will be asked to attend the meeting on Sept. 16th. to represent the Town on the question of amending the Agreement for Waste Handling with Regional Waste Systems, Inc.

Roads: Fred Fay Rd. Comm. will meet with the Board to review the road accounts at 9:30 AM. Thursday Sept. 4th. Fay was appointed Winter Roads Foreman.

Recycling Committee: David Buck met with Selectman Fay and it was agreed that Buck would be the Chairman of the two man Committee. Selectman Fay noted that a meeting regarding recycling would be held tomorrow evening in the Town of Bath. Fay said that Buck could also check other Town's that had recycling such as, Wells, So. Harpswell, also some of the Town's and cities in other States. The Town raised \$200.00 at last Annual Town Meeting for the Committee's use, and a report is to be submitted by next Town Meeting.

Selectmen's Secretary: Interviews were held with four applicant's for the job. Barbara Trask, Marilyn Cragin, Diane Drapeau and Robin Day. Diane Drapeau was hired for the replacement of Jean Chick. Drapeau will receive \$6.45 per hour. It was voted to pay Jean Chick a week's vacation.
