Selectmen's Report given by Andrew Woodsome, Jr. Chrmn. of the Board of Selectmen.

All but 5 lots were sold, being picked up by the first bidder, on elot Map 32 Lot 45 is pending. On four of the lots the second bidder has been noyified. The Secretary to the Board of Selectmen position is still open.

Roads:Rd. Comm. Fred Fay reported that on the Hamilton Road four culverts have been set with two more to be set. Roads at Westwinds are dug out gravel will be hauled in next week. The footing has been dug out for the building at the Stump Dump area that will be used as a Salt Shed and waiting for the cement to be poured. Selectmen will contact the National Guard to get their equipment out of the Dump area.

SAD #57: Director Judy Carll reported that the new schools in Limerick and Newfield had been ok'ed. The new addition at the high school is in operation. Millard Genthner questioned Judy about the taping of the SAD Director's meeting being taped and why it was voted down. Judy said that she was not at that meeting but did feel that they should be taped. Public can go in and tape the Board meetings, but the Board will not tape.


