

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

October 7, 1986

PRESENT: Andrew C. Woodsome, Chrm. of the Board. Dennis Abbott, Selectmen. Robert C. Fay, Selectmen. Diane Holden, Tax Collector. Tim Nelson, Code Enforcement Officer. James McFarland, concerned citizen.

Water Testing: A letter will be written to Mr. Henry Aho explaining that since Southern Maine Finishing ceased operation the water samples taken from Cook's Brook on Route 202 show a substantial drop in the Cadmium level. A copy of the Peck Lab. Report will be sent to Dennis Merrill.

Tim Nelson, Code Enforcement Officer, will meet with Robert Dennett of the Peck Lab. on Thursday, October 9, 1986 at 9:00A.M. to test the Water at its highest point. Location of the test will be Wade Judkins Barn well. Results of the test are needed by Monday, October 13, 1986 or in Tuesdays mail delivery.

Stump Dump: Robert C. Fay was nominated by A.C. Woodsome and seconded by D. Abbott as chairman to the Usable & Burnable Stump Dump Wood Committee.

Tractor: Insurance coverage was approved to remain at a valuation of 36,000.00 and a cost of \$648.00 A copy of the lease must be attained and it is to remain in the office.

An Article must be put in the Town Warrent giving the Selectmen the authority to sell the tractor when the market is right. Ambition no cost of use of the tractor for 2 years.

Board of Selectmen must meet with Fred Fay, Road Commissioner, to establish a set of rules and regulations for the tractor.

McFarland:

have no authority concerning school bus routes, but they have directed Mr. McFarland to talk with Jerome McGillicuddy, Traffic Manager of S.A.D. 57. If he does not get the results he is to contact the directors and the School Board.
