

Selectmen's Minutes

November 25, 1986

PRESENT: Dennis Abbott, Robert Fay, Members of the Board of Selectmen, Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr., Chairman of the Board of Selectmen, Millard Genter, Concerned Citizen.

Bacteria: Millard Genter discussed with the Board the Bacteria problem on Pearl Street. He dropped off copies of water test results taken from various wells on Pearl Street. Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr motioned to hold a meeting and invite concerned citizens to discuss a plan of action to tackle this bacteria problem.

Neil Raymond, Millard Genter, John Monteith and the Board of Selectmen met with Edward Bradley, a consulting Geologist, to discuss a possible geological study of the aqua flow in the Waterboro Village area. The meeting was adjourned from the Selectmen's Office and revented upstairs so everyone could look at the big maps.

Mr. Bradley said it would cost approxiamtely \$700.00 to \$900.00 for him to derive an estimate on the total cost for a comprehensive geological study. He guessed that this figure would be anywhere from 10 to 30 thousand dollars. Cost does depend on modeling. Mr. Bradley was sure to say that he could give the Board an assesment of the geological chemical problem but not neccessarily a solution. Mr. Bradley will get back to the Board with a price in a week or two.

Robert Fay made a motion to hire Mr. Bradley for a preliminary study and Dennis Abbott seconded.

ZBA: Robert Fay voted yes and Dennis Abbott seconded to approve Millard Genter's suggestion of adding the property zone on to the ZBA information Sheet.

Thanksgiving Baskets: 12 Baskets were donated from local organizations and churches the Selectmen voted on who should get them. Van Foglio will deliver them on Wednesday November 27, 1986

Petition: Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr. motioned and Robert Fay seconded to waive petitions from YCCA and Channel 10.

Lake Sherbourne Dam: Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr. signed the National Guard Form and it will be mailed tomorrow.

A.C. Woodsome motioned to retain the old heaters and use them in the Town Hall Basement.
