

SELECTMEN MINUTES
September 1, 1987

PRESENT: Bob Fay, Chairman, Dennis Abbott.

DEAN WATERHOUSE: Dean was in to see the Selectmen to discuss a problem he is having with Howard Stone. Howard feels that Dean is hauling out of Town rubbish. Dean explained that he was not and has not hauled out of Town rubbish and he explained his routes. Vote was taken to set a policy that if someone is caught dumping out of Town trash that they will lose dump privileges for 30 days.

MUD STOMPERS: The Mud Stompers want to schedule another mud rally for September 20. Two representatives for the Mud Stompers and a representative from the State Police and a Town Constable was present. The State Police discussed the problem they had at the last mud rally. The club will change their rules and shortened the program. Questions were asked and answered about security and controlling drinking. This license will have stipulations attached. FRED FAY: Fred explained to the Board what he has been doing on the Jellerson Road.
