

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
September 15, 1987

PRESENT: Chm. Bob Fay, Dennis G. Abbott, Andrew C. Woodsome, Selectmen. Steve Kasprzak, Jean Chick, Dale Whitman, Frank Allen, Ed Doggett from the Finance Committee.

The Selectmen met with the Finance Committee to explain how they came up with the figures on the Warrant. The Finance Committee had questions on the Gift Lots, what type of lots they were. The Board of Selectmen explained that they just wanted a clarification on how to dispose of gift lots, either by sealed bids or public auction. The Board feels that more money is generated at a public auction. On article 2 the legal account is 12 thousand dollars in the hole due to various legal actions being taken by the Town. More money is needed for the stump dump due to the fact that the white goods have to be hauled off and a fee has to be paid and the addition of one added attendant. The Board explained how the Teacher Grant works and why \$125.00 is needed for the grant for affordable housing. The Board feels that fees should generate back into the office supplies and equipment account.

The Assessing Board of Review is set to meet on Sept. 24. to review Frank Tarbox's abatement.

ROBERT JONES: Pictures were shown to the Board of garbage being buried on his property on Rt. 202. The Board has informed the CEO to inspect his property because he is not complying with his conditional use permit issued by the Planning Board. The Board also informed the Health Officer to inspect for a possible dump.
