

MINUTES OF SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
September 29, 1987

PRESENT: Chairman Robert C. Fay, Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr., Carol White, Ed Bradley and Tim Nelson.

Carol White informed the Board that a firm has been found to do the testing on Southern Maine Finishing. The firm is Acheron, Inc. The Board will send a letter to the Acheron, Inc. firm asking that a plan be submitted in a week. The Board will be sending a copy of the agenda for the meeting with DEP to Carol White and Ed Bradley. Carol White would like to ask DEP why SMF was not tested for cyanide. Carol White showed on a map the areas for testing for water. Carol stated that they would be testing five wells, GTE, 2 by SMF, and Clints Marine and Ramsell residence. No well testing has been done yet but a lab has been found to do the testing. The lab is Contract Lab in Cambridge, Ma. This is the only lab on East Coast that is certified for superfund testing. A local lab will be used for bacterial testing. Carol White will be driving the samples to Mass. Selectmen Woodsome asked why gas is in Post Office's water and not down further. Carol Explained how gas would move vertically or horizontally and also could be moving beyond the well. Carol stated that DEP is calling it gasoline for purpose of getting funding. Carol will be preparing a report for the Towns people. Selectmen Fay would like to know what is the point if cyanide is found in water to be dangerous to people. Tim Nelson reported that he is ready for inspection at Technical Industries and Mike Emmons has been notified and can go on inspection.
