

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES  
August 22, 1989

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chairman Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr., Dennis G. Abbott.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

NEW BUSINESS:

VAN FOGLIO: Van showed the Board a copy of a letter that Game Warden Mark Warren received on a complaint that someone is melting lead and the septic system is draining into the lake. Van also showed the Board the file that he has on Tim McCandless. In April of 1988 Van sent a letter to him about his sewerage problem. At that time Mr. McCandless requested to go before the Planning Board to do some work on his camp at the same time he was fixing his septic system. He never showed up for his appointment with the Planning Board. This problem has been going on for some time. Mr. McCandless talked to Van tonight and he can't get a loan to fix it and his place is for sale. Chairman Woodsome told Van to call Karen Lovell and see if and what can be done to get them to fix the septic system. Sel. Abbott asked to check into about the Town fixing it and then leining the property.

Board received the test results on mercury that Bob Dennett did on the Dewitt's water. The test showed the mercury to be less than .002 which is almost negative. The lab stated that for that concentration of mercury on the first test, a thermometer has to be broken into the test sample.

Board voted due to increased problem of the door by the cemetary being left unlocked, that a dead bolt lock be added and the door down cellar and the door at the top of the stairs also have a dead bolt added. Only Town Committees will be allowed to use that room upstairs for meetings and a key will be issued only after a schedule of meetings have been submitted to the Selectmen's Office.

Board signed the lein release deed for Map 11 Lot 41, to Casco Northern Bank.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.
