

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
11/27/90

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Robert C. Fay, John C. Monteith.

DOUG KNIGHT: Doug came before the Board to discuss recycling the tires at the dump. He does do business with several other Towns. The other Towns do not charge him and he doesn't charge the Town for the tires that he takes. The Board voted to try him for 90 days and Doug will bring in several copies of his contracts with other Towns and the Board will draw one up and sign it next week.

TOWN REPORTS: The Board discussed printing of the Annual Town Report in March or June of next year. Art Smith, Finance Comm. Chairman, was also present. Art feels that there should be a small financial statement for the March meeting and the full report for the June Town Meeting. Board voted to have a financial report for March Town Meeting and the full report for the June meeting. The Board also voted to go out to bid for proposals for doing the audit. The ad will be put in the Sunday Portland Telegram. The Board also discussed with Art the upcoming Special Town Meeting. Dianne had requested that her office renovation proposal be put on the warrant. The Board would like to see it on the March warrant. A copy of her request was given to Art. The Board asked Art to discuss it with his Finance Comm. members at there meeting next Monday and give the Board their recommendation.

JOE SIMANNOK: Joe came in to discuss with the Board about giving him permission to get some items from the white goods pile. Chm. Fay explained the dump rules to him. If things can be set aside that people can use then they should be. If there is something specific that he needs without going through the whole white goods pile then the Board will give him a pass to pick the items up. Joe told the Board that he feels like he is being treated like an idiot at the dump. He can go to the dump and put something on the white goods pile but he is not allowed to pick something up from the pile. He is not a dump picker but is a recycler. The Board will give him a pass to pick up a water heater, rubber bike tires, and Florence oil burner parts. Chm. Fay also informed him of the Waste Task Committee and the Recycling Committee.

Board voted to appoint Maura Kruegar to the Taylor House Board of Trustees. Voted, Passed.

Board voted to allow the CEO/Building Office to have office hours on Tuesday nights from 6-8 p.m instead of 6-9 p.m.

Board voted to send a letter to V.P. & L.E. Smith owners of Ledgemere Dam permission to close off the New Dam Road and Bridge in the event of an emergency.
