

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
3/12/91

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Robert C. Fay, Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Bob Gobeil came in to discuss with the Board the purchase orders for the youth league. The youth league has been ordering the items then coming into the office for a purchase order. Sel. Abbott called Craig Tilton and explained to him how purchase orders work.

NEW BUSINESS:

BRUNETTI'S RESTAURANT: Chm Fay opened up the hearing for Brunetti's Restaurant Liquor License hearing. Board voted to approve the the liquor license application.

ROAD REVIEW COMM; Fred Fay and Doug Foglio, Jr. came in to discuss bids on the Clarks Bridge Road. The Board suggested having Sebago Technics do the bid package with stipulations requested by the Road Review Committee. Fred will call Sebago Technics tomorrow and discuss it. Fred also discussed with the Board the dam. Repair is needed right away, water is getting under it and deteriorating the cement. Fred will contact several companies to get a price on fixing the dam. Also discusses with the Board on what to do with the stumps at the stump dump. Board decided to wait until next month after it thaws so no loam will be lost.

MARK CALDWELL: Mark updated the Board on what they have been doing with assessing.

BRUCE KIMBALL: Bruce came in to discuss the survey on his property that abutts Friendship Park. Sebago Technics has done the survey of the park and agrees with Bruce's survey on the back line. Bruce's new survey shows that they own over 100 acres and not 11 acra. Mark went over the maps and the surveys with Burce.

MILLARD GENTHNER: Millard presented the Board his proposal on dump hours #1 was for 35 hrs. #2 is for 32 hrs. #3 is for 29 hrs. The proposal will be to the Waste Task Committee to review and give their recommendation to the Board. Sel. Monteith and Chm. Fay recommends proposal #3. The Board will have Richmond Stevens in next week to discuss Sunday dump hours.

Board at this time went into executive session to discuss personnel matters.
