SELECTMEN'S REPORT: Chm Abbott reported that the tax bills will be sent out next week and due November 15th. There are still a few openings on several committees and if anyone is interested to contact the Selectmen's Office. Martha Lariviere is putting the newsletter together. The tax maps are being updated. Also ask the committee chairmen to let the Selectmen's Office know when they meet and what time. The audit is being finalized and will be going to a General Ledger format as soon as the figures are done on the audit. The traffic light at the intersection of Rte 202 and West Road, DOT stated that it would take six months from start to finish. Rep. Lord is trying to find out what the status is of the project. Bob Fay asked about the selling of the Lake Arrowhead lots for the purchase of Steve Kasprzak's land. At the last bids that were sent out, 10 bids came back. Will be checking into a grant. The lake will be lowered this weekend about 3 feet. Oct. 1st is the date every year. The assessor has moved to Farmington. Board is in search of a part-time assessor. The General Assistance has been busy.

TOWN CLERK/TAX COLLECTOR/TREASUER: No report.

ROAD COMMISSIONER: Fred reported that paving will begin next week. Have started the intersection at Ross Corner and West Road. General work is also being done.

SAD #57 DIRECTORS: No report.

FIRE DEPT. & RESCUE: Tom Jones reported. the resuce had 10 calls in 48 hours and had to use both ambulances at times. Starting to work on the new radio system from low band to UHF.

PLANNING BOARD: Roland Denby reported that the Board has been busy. One meeting a month is held just for rewriting the zoning and the other meeting is for business. One trailer park is in process, and one subdivision. One subdivision may have to be reviewed, due to the fees for the orginal subdivision was not ever paid. Will have to start the process over.

TOWN PLANNER/SELECTMEN'S ASSISTANT: Dwayne Morin reported that is has been working with the Planning Board, looking at the financial situation. working on the water system. Looks like the Town will receive about \$9,000. back for Huricane Bob damage.

PARKS & RECREATION COMM: Bob Gobeil reported on the kids that he had this summer and the prjects that they completed. The lights for the ball field at the Lion's Club has been delivered. Have had the toilets removed a month early to save money.

FINANCE COMMITTEE: No report. Chm. Abbott stated that he would like the budget requestes in by the first of the year to get the budget process started.

SACO RIVER CORRIDOR COMM: No report.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: No report. Meeting tonight.

CONSTABLES: Chauncey reported. Asked if there was going to be a general clean up in Town like last year. Chm. Abbott stated that there will probably be someone hired to clean up the back roads before snow falls. There is a real problem with cats.

CONSERVATION COMMISSION: No report but they meet on the 2nd Weds. of the month.

HAZARDOUS WASTE COMM: Pam reported that they meet on the 2nd Weds. of the month. There have been a lot of changes in regulations. Have not received any of the changes yet.

REGIONAL WASTE: Frank Allen reported that the Gorham site is waiting for the Army Corp. of Engineers.

CABLE TV: Frank Allen reported that the committee has not been meeting.

RECYCLING & COMPOSTING COMM: No report.

SOUTHERN MAINE REGIONAL PLANNING: No report.
