

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

11/21/91

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith, Frank R. Allen, Jr.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin and Arthur Smith.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

ROAD COMMISSIONER: The Board asked Fred in to discuss several things. The Board asked why F H Scott sent in one bill when there was to be three separate bills sent. There is about 14,000+ in the Roads and Bridges account. The Board also discussed with Fred about where he piled the sand at the dump. Fred doesn't feel it will bother the monitor wells but Sel. Monteith stated that it is only about 30 yards away from the well. Fred told the Board that they put up about 1200 yards of sand for the winter today. He figures that he will need about 3,000 yards total. There is about 200 ton of salt mixed in with the sand. Fred asked the Board about the dam and getting it fixed. The Board suggested contacting Pepin to see what can be done. D.O.T. has started the hands on grader school in Town today. Chm. Abbott asked about the bus turn around at Edgecomb Bridge. The Board was never asked about having one there, Fred was the one that was contacted and he just put one in. Fred understands that in the future all requests for bus turn arounds will need to get the Board of Selectmen's approval first. There is about 600+ yards of loam that has been screened and can be sold in the spring at the dump. The Board told Fred to take it easy on spending any money in the roads account. Fred asked the Board if he could put some trees along the pit so people can back up and throw their brush into the pit to be burned. The Board approved Fred putting the trees along the pit. Sel. Monteith would like to see the stump dump closed during the winter. Chm. Abbott agrees and to have one attendnat up there for just one day a week Fred will go up and talk to the people who are cutting trees along the New Dam Road about cutting the pines that are there also. Fred will also go up and cut the two trees by the boat launch that have been broken.

NEW BUSINESS:

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed with the Board the resumes that have been received for the part-time assessor. The Board will contact Mark Caldwell to see if he is interested in submitting an resume. The Board will interview Walton Hanson, C. Gardner Lane and Michelle Boisjoly. The Board voted to go with Electric Light Company to install the traffic light at the intersection of Rte 202 and West Road. Also discussed reinvesting the \$90,000 in a CD. The Board voted to reinvest but also had Linda Omith from Key Bank out to talk to the Board. John Smith has contacted Dwayne about purchasing the flags for Memorial Day next year. Board suggests that he check with Flag Wavers to see what they can do for prices. John's prices are for flags .80¢ each and \$6.80 per holder. The Board voted to allow John Smith his Veteran's Exemption on his 1992 taxes. The Board went over the charts that Dwayne had done on the budget. Also discussed what is happening with the water system. Had to replace a piece of the pipe and there is about 500 feet of pipe left to test. After December 13th, there will be a \$400.00 per day charge to M & H for not completing the project. The Board also discussed the illegal subdivision on the Goodwin Mills Road. The Board voted to handle this situation the same as the Starrett Pierce's subdivision in N. Waterboro This subdivision is to be treated the same to bring it into compliance.

BOB GOBEL: Chm. Abbott told Bob to be sure to contact the coaches of the Babe Ruth teams to be sure that they get funding for next summer also. They have not been contacted in the past. Bob will contact the coaches to see what they will need for money.

The Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.

The sand bid was awarded to F. R. Carroll.
