

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES  
11/26/91

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith, Frank R. Allen, Jr.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne G. Morin and Martha LaRiviere

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

Martha was in to ask questions concerning Town finances for the newsletter. Chm Abbott explained how the money is used. CD money has been used to purchase a new pumper for the Fire Dept. and the Taylor House but it is paid back. The Board is looking into putting the Towns money into one bank instead of 6 banks due to interest rate on TAN. Also told Martha that the loam at the dump will be sold to residents in the Spring.

NEW BUSINESS:

RICHMOND STEVENS: Richmond brought in the contract between Custom Transfer and the Town of Waterboro for the transfer station at the dump. Richmond also brought in the budget for 1992. His budget is for \$62,651 for 230 tons to be hauled to RWS. Any change in the dump hours will be adjusted. The Board agreed to have Atty. Karen Lovell review the contract before the Board signs. Richmond was in agreement and signed two copies of the contract.

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne reported that the pump house is almost finished and there are nine homes left to be hooked up. Fred Fay accepted all the roads and will review again next year. D.O.T will not accept or reject anything until next Spring. The door for the pump house will be here Friday. The water should be turned on by mid December.

The Board will meet with Roger Elliott to discuss Charles Thornton. The Board will answer with one letter stating the Towns position.

The Board agreed to have the Road Commissioner fill out a work plan form for work for the week on roads.

Board signed the warrant for payment of bills and payroll.

The Board will be interviewing three people for the part-time assessor position on Weds., Dec. 6 starting at 7:00 p.m.
