

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 8, 1994

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: John C. Monteith and Robert C. Fay.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne G. Morin and Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne has received a quote on the signs for the transfer station. Quote was for \$109.08 plus \$30.00 installation fee. Board voted to have the signs made by RSD Graphics as per the quote. The three quotes on the caterpillar tractor should be in this week. Also Allen's Screen Printing will have a quote by the middle on next week on dump stickers. Millard Genthner has also brought to Dwayne's attention that dumping of shingles on Sunday is getting out of hand. The Board voted not to allow dumping the shingles on Sunday. Dwayne will have a notice put in The Smart Shopper. Board voted to have Sebago Technics draw up a plan for storage of wood at the transfer station and Dwayne will check with D.E.P. for usage before approval. Dwayne updated the Board on the Walton case. Atty. Roger Elliott would like to meet with the Board to discuss options. The judge ruled in favor of Mr. Walton and Town will need to pay his legal fees and deed him the three waterfront lots.

STEVE EVERETT: Steve, Chairman of the Conservation Commission has been contacted by Clayton Hurlburt for the town to purchase his property located on Ossipee Mountain. He has offered to sell to the Town the 45 acre and the 25 acre parcel for \$40,000. The 20 acre parcel he is willing to sell for \$15,000. in the future. Sel. Fay suggests a purchase agreement with Mr. Hurlburt. Board will hold a Special Town Meeting to purchase the properties.

GLENN BEAN, SR.: Glenn told the Board that the paving is done except for Roberts Ridge Road. Roberts Ridge Road will be done in the Spring. Glenn would like to put a shim coat on the New Dam Road. The cost will be \$4,200. Dwayne suggests asking the Road Review Committee for their opinion on the New Dam Road. Sel. Fay and Sel. Monteith do not have a problem with the shim coat on the New Dam Road. Board also asked Dwayne to get a quote from F. H. Scott on paving the library parking lot, Rte 5 area and the transfer station. Board gave Glenn approval for the shim coat on the New Dam Road. Sel. Fay asked when the salt & sand pile would be put up. Glenn will let Dwayne know on Monday on how much salt to order.
