

**COUNCIL MEETING
DECEMBER 13, 1994**

SELECTMEN'S REPORT: Chm. Abbott reported that the foyer has been completed. There has been a amendment to the winter sand policy, two pails at any one trip. Holiday dump hours for the transfer station will be closed Dec. 25, Dec. 26 and Dec.27. Also Jan. 1, Jan. 2, & Jan. 3. The Audit has been completed and the Board will be meeting with the auditor at next weeks Selectmen's meeting. Have settled with Mr. Walton, the judgement is for \$20,000. and the three lots.

FIRE DEPT.: Chm. Abbott introduced newly elected Fire Chief Kevin Theriault. Kevin introduced Tom Jones as 1st Asst. Chief and Frank Birkemose ad 2nd Asst. Chief. Kevin told everyone that the dept. is willing to work with the town, it is long overdue. Wants a good working relationship with the town. Also reported that burning permits are now available at Grave's General Store. Tom stated that there are some stipulations on the permits, have worked with the Forest Service. Also will be going to a purchase order system for better accountability.

CONSTABLE: Chauncey asked if there was anything the town could do to see about getting a red light installed at the intersection of Town House Road and Rte 5. Chm. Abbott told him that it would need to go through D.O.T. Perhaps the town has had a safety engineer look at several other areas, may need to have him look at that one.

SAD #57: Millard reported that on Nov. 16th a Public Hearing was held and 40 people attended, 90% were teachers.

TOWN STRUCTURE COMM: Gus requested a letter from the Selectmen on what direction the committee should take. Chm. Abbott stated that both Hollis and Buxton have Town Structure Committee's and possibly see what direction they are taking.

OSSIPEE LAKE ASSOC.: Don reported that new signs will be made over the winter months for installation next Spring. Will start meeting again in the Spring.

TOWN CLERK/TAX COLLECTOR/TREASURER: Dianne reported that the 1995 hunting and fishing licenses are in. Price is up \$2.00 more from last year. State is also looking at changing the registrations to look similar to the titles.

GENERAL DISCUSSION: Frank Allen asked about revitalizing the Recycling Comm. Chm. Abbott stated need to get people involved. Frank stated that he would be Chairman to get the committee going again.
