

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
FEBRUARY 14, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith and Robert C. Fay.
Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, Finance Committee member Art Smith and SAD Director Millard Genthner.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chm. Abbott opened up the Public Hearing for a Victualer's License for Roge's Restaurant (Roger Wilson). Sel. Fay made the motion to issue a Victualer's License, Sel. Monteith seconded, voted, passed.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed several issues with the Board.

1. Reviewed the letter received from Atty. Chris Vaniotis in regards to foreclosing on the Southern Maine Finishing property. Atty. Vaniotis recommends not to foreclose. Sel. Fay asked if there was another way to collect the back taxes. Dwayne told the Board could go to small claims court but Atty. Vaniotis feels would not be worth it.
2. Reviewed letter from Atty. Karen Lovell in regards to a letter received by the Board from Charles M. Thornton. Chm. Abbott suggested that Atty. Lovell write a letter and have it sent out of the Selectmen's Office to Mr. Thornton.
3. On Thursday Dwayne will be going to Augusta when the commission report is released on school funding.
4. Parks & Rec. voted at their meeting Monday night to hire Andrea Lefevbre as the summer maintenance person for this summer upon approval of the Board of Selectmen. Board of Selectmen approved Andrea as the summer maintenance person.

ANDREA LEFEVBRE: Parks & Rec. voted to pay Bergeron Excavating \$500. for work on the new tennis, basketball, skateboard court at Friendship Park. Andrea explained that the project took longer and required more loam than anticipated. In the beginning planned to burn the brush there, but instead had to haul it off to the dump. Chm. Abbott asked if he told the Parks & Rec. about the cost prior to doing the work. Andrea told the Board that the committee voted to pay the \$500. out of the trust fund for Friendship Park. Bergeron did save \$2,000 to \$2,400. for the work that he did, the \$500. was for over and above. Board approved paying \$500. out of the Friendship Park trust fund to Bergeron Excavating.

Discussed Pee Wee Wrestling. It has been rejuvenated and would like to go through the town for insurance rider. It would be for 21 children 12 and under all from Waterboro. Chm. Abbott asked if other towns are involved. Andrea told the Board that all six towns are in it. Only looking for insurance for Waterboro involved children. Chm. Abbott asked about how kids from other town will do if not covered by insurance. Andrea told the Board that it would be up to each individual town to get insurance. Andrea told the Board that Parks & Rec. has voted to donate \$200. for headgear for Waterboro kids. Dwayne has not received a quote for insurance, need to fill out a questionnaire on how many kids are involved and their ages. Andrea told the Board that the \$200. will be taken out of the car show proceeds which they use for solicitations advertisements etc. Board approved the \$200. donation. Discussed the former Shaker Valley Little League. Chm. Abbott asked where the money is. Andrea told the Board that what she understands, is it is in a checking account with the secretary's name on it.

GREGORY MELHORN: Greg was in to discuss the new Shaker Valley Little League. Chm. Abbott asked what is he looking for from the town. Greg told the Board just cheaper insurance. A questionnaire will need to be filled out before a quote can be obtained. Greg told the Board that he was under the assumption was covered under the town's liability insurance. Dwayne told Greg that the would need number of kids, ages, number of teams and number of coaches.

The Board at this time met with the Finance Committee to go over the Board of Selectmen's budget request.
