

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
MARCH 21, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. Dennis G. Abbott, John C. Monteith and Robert C. Fay.

Also present; Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, Finance Committee member Art Smith and Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DIANNE HOLDEN: Last fall when the tax bills were mailed out, they were two part tax bills. Dianne asked if a post card should be mailed as a reminder. Board agreed that a post card should be sent as a reminder.

Discussed town meeting. Two organizations have approached the town to have food tables at town meeting in June. One is the Rebekah Lodge and the other is the Cub Scouts. In the past, Taylor House has had the food and Historical Society has had the food sale. Will contact Jim Carll to see if the Taylor House and Historical Society are doing the food.

Sel. Fay asked Bob Gobeil to keep his truck out of the way when he works at the transfer station. Bob told the Board that he hasn't been parking to block it off.

The Board at this time adjourned to the Town Hall to conduct this month's Council Meeting.

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed the following issues with the Board:

1. MDOT has issued an order which will move the blinking light to the intersection of Town House Road and Route 5. They will also install additional stop signs and mark the road with stop ahead markings. Lee Chace will contact the town prior to the work being completed.
2. Rescue personnel Beverly Sinclair was injured on a rescue call. The bill for her hospital visit was for \$78.00. Board voted to pay the bill and not claim it as a Worker's Comp.
3. There is a draft copy of the June warrant in the Selectmen's files.
4. Town cover report. An idea for the report is to have a picture of Ossipe Lake as a wrap around cover. Sewall Co quoted a price of \$600. for a black and white aerial and \$800. for a color aerial and \$1,000. for both.
