

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

June 20, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: John C. Monteith and Robert C. Fay.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil.

NEW BUSINESS:

FIRE DEPT.: Kevin Theriault, Tom Jones, Frank Birkemose, Jr. and Elias Smith represented the Fire Dept. Discussed the overpayment to Kevin Theriault. Board agreed to subtract \$75.00 each month until the overpayment is taken care of approximately 9 months. Discussed only allowing five burning permits. Kevin explained that the reason only five permits are issued each day is due to man power will review the policy to see if on rainy day more permits can be issued.

CROSSWALK: Sel. Monteith reported that he has received a call requested either a pedestrian sign or a crosswalk by Sunnyside Cottages. Due to it being on Rte. 5, D.O.T. would have to be notified and permission given to the town.

At this time the Board adjourned to the Town Hall to conduct this month's Council Meeting.

Sel. Fay asked Pat Caron where the Town Hall is being used more and more if it would be possible for the club houses to be used instead. Pat told the Board that he didn't see a reason why. Sel. Fay suggested that at the bottom of the calendar that will be put in The Smart Shopper a line be added to say the club houses can be used for rentals. Discussed fire station and a ballfield. Pat told the Board that when he leaves for Florida, the idea gets dropped.

Dwayne showed the Board sample charts and a sample survey on waste. Sel. Fay suggests doing the survey after the July Council Meeting when that meeting is devoted to waste.

Road Commissioner elect Fred Fay has asked what the pay will be for the road workers. Now the pay is \$7.28 per hour. When there was a change in Road Commissioners before the pay stayed the same. Also Dwayne did an attachment to the Hollis agreement that shows the dates their residents can use the stump dump and what they can bring in. Will forward to Hollis Selectmen.

Board also discussed the CEO hours. Sel. Fay and Montieth feel hours should not be set by an individual should have control over it. Will discuss further when Sel. Abbott is present.
