

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
JULY 25, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. John C. Monteith, Robert C. Fay and Dennis G. Abbott.

Also present. Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil and RWS Representative Frank Allen.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed the following with the Board.

- **Conservation Commission:** Sel. Abbott feels this committee needs to get stimulated. Board agreed to have them come in and meet with the Board.
- **RWS:** Sel. Abbott suggests having Rep. Mike McAlevy and Sen. Lord meet with the Board and go into RWS for a tour, neither has been on a tour through RWS.
- **Roberts Ridge Road:** Needs to be shoulder on the new pavement section, hardly no room for shoulders. Also Sel. Abbott stated that need to spend time cutting brush on paved roads not back roads.
- **Cemetery Fund:** Dwayne told the Board that the interest comes out to pay for mowing. Board feels needs a vote and a Finance Committee recommendation. Dwayne told the Board that it is covered in Parks & Rec. budget.
- Sel. Abbott asked why no interest on the implementation money grant. Dwayne told him that the money has to be put in a non interest bearing account.
- Sel. Abbott asked about Old Home Days Trust Fund. Parks & Rec. comes before the Board to ask permission to draw down, never does Old Home Days.
- **Blackburn's:** Have contact D.O.T., and the state can remove the docks. Didn't say they would, but can remove them. Dwayne will contact them further. According to zoning, only one dock is allowed.
- Sel. Abbott suggests having Mike get ahold of D.O.T. on the West Road Bridge, and the intersection of Rte.5 and Town House Road. Both are scheduled to be repaired.

NEW BUSINESS:

Board agreed that animal control calls go to Chauncey Gerry first and Bob Vermeulen as a back up if Chauncey can't do it.

RONALD ALVARADO: Was in to discuss his back taxes. His mobile is on the tax title property auction list and would like permission to make payments. Board approved Ronald Alvarado making a down payment of \$200.00 then four payments of \$250.00 per month and remove the property from the auction list.
