

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES  
AUGUST 22, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. John C. Monteith, Robert C. Fay and Dennis G. Abbott.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, and SAD Director Millard Genthner.

**REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:**

Sel. Fay made the motion not to allow for disposal of stumps at the transfer station. Chm. Monteith stated that the Town needs to do something about the crushing being piled up with no way to expand. Dwayne and Millard went over the plans for the transfer station for traffic flow. Board will set aside time at next weeks Selectmen's meeting to discuss in detail the transfer station. Millard asked the Board if it was all right for the dump attendants to do the same as last year while Mike was away. Board approved.

Chm. Monteith asked Fred Fay about the gates at the dam being opened. Fred reported that the gate is closed and the water loss is due to boats and the weather. Chm. Monteith told Fred that he looked at the gates last Thurs. and they were opened.

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed the following with the Board:

- Commercial Paving will pick up the shingles for \$63.00 a ton which includes providing the town with a container and hauling them off. Sel. Abbott suggested the town purchasing a truck, Sel. Fay agreed. Dwayne suggested buying two thirty yard containers for \$9,000. It cost \$65.00 a ton to dispose of sheetrock at TurnKey and \$43.00 a ton for shingles. Industrial Metals will pay \$10.00 a ton for white goods.
- Survey: Middle Branch will survey for \$2,900. Sebago Technics quote was for \$4,200. Chm. Monteith made the motion to go with Middle Branch Surveying, Sel. Abbott seconded, voted, passed.
- Burning permit: Dwayne has met with the Fire Chief and the Town has a reserve burning permit, but will need to check first.

The Board at this time adjourned to the Town Hall to conduct this month's Council Meeting.
