

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 17, 1995

Regular meeting of the Waterboro Board of Selectmen.

PRESENT: Chm. John C. Monteith and Dennis G. Abbott.

Also present: Selectmen's Assistant Dwayne Morin, Parks & Rec. Chm. Bob Gobeil, SAD Director Millard Genthner, and Finance Committee member Art Smith.

NEW BUSINESS:

FIRE DEPT.: Kevin Theriault, Tom Jones and Frank Birkemose came in to discuss putting their clerk on for 40 hours a week. She will be a full time clerk and paramedic. Sel. Abbott asked how many hours does Ginny work now and Tom replied 30+ each week. Kevin also added that the job would include benefits. Chm. Monteith asked what the benefits would be and the reply was for medical and dental. Now the cost per month for medical would be \$239. Her wage would be \$9.50 per hour for 40 hour work week. Chm. Monteith asked where their budget was for 30 hours a week, can the Fire Dept. cover the extra costs. Sel. Abbott added also the benefits, is there an additional account it could come out of. Tom told the Board that she would not be paid per call while working the 40 hours. Sel. Abbott told them that once the funding is exhausted, they would need to reimburse through the Town. Tom feels could move money from other account to cover. Kevin also told the Board that the Fire Dept. has a \$5,000. bond that they could use. Sel. Abbott asked if they have a full time paramedic would it change the insurance rate. Dwayne told them that it could increase. Sel. Abbott told them on the surface, no problem just adding 10 more hours a week plus benefits. One way or another will come out of the Fire Dept. budget. Kevin told the Board that she would like insurance for her and one child. Dwayne told them that the town only pays for the employee. Sel. Abbott asked what is the pay for paramedics Tom replied for just a paramedic \$9.-\$10. per hour. She will need to come under the Towns health insurance. Dwayne will break it down for budget purposed for what the costs will be. Both Sel. Abbott and Chm. Monteith do not see any reason that would prohibit adding a full time clerk, but will need to set a precedence for any future requests. Will need to go through the Town's payroll.

REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:

DWAYNE MORIN: Dwayne discussed the following with the Board:

Deering Ridge Road: the driver of the accident was cited for speeding. The traffic engineer has looked at it and the road work was not signed right. D.E.P. showed up and the brook needs to have silk screen. Fred has put up some bales.

Army Corp. of Engineers would like work next summer in town. Parks & Rec. and the Road Review Committee will provide a project list.

Maurice St. Peter would like the old wood at the dump.

Septic waste meeting. There are a few alternatives, one is Sanford won't shut the towns off. Another it is up to the 17 towns. Suggestion was to contact other septic waste systems to see if they will allow the town to use their facility or all 17 towns get together for their own system. Sanford won't lose any revenue if they drop the towns. 1.8 million gallons are from the other towns at six cents a gallon. Have double their price so they won't lose any revenues.

Board granted permission to put curtains on the balcony and windows in the Town Hall. Board also agreed to keep the temperature at 60 degrees.

Letter slot. Portland Glass has given a approximate quote of \$100. to install a letter slot.

Cardboard: Sel. Abbott suggest bailing then sliding into a covered container. Would probably cut 1/3 of the bulk.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

The Board went into executive session at 8:25 for a hardship abatement request.
