

SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

February 12, 2002

PRESENT: Bob Fay, Willis Lord, Nancy Brandt, Pam Witman, Bob Gobeil, Paul Kussman, Richard Sevigny, Tammy Wells, Howard Doe, John Littlefield, David Benton, Teresa Lowell, Eric Herrle, Frank Tarazewich, and Jason L'Heureux.

Meeting called to order at 8:50 p.m.

HEARING OF DELEGATION

Richard Sevigny read a written statement regarding the status of Eon Way. Stated that Little Ossipee Estates is an approved sub-division. Also found that the road book lists it as a public road. Believes that it is an approved public road and perhaps in the past some paperwork may have been lost or misplaced. Asked that the Selectmen vote to put Eon Way on the warrant for the annual town meeting to have it accepted as a town dirt road. Paul Kussman stated that it will be a loss to the community by Bob not running for another term as Selectman even though they have not always agreed on certain issues. Stated that Eon Way is listed as a public road in town records as well as the history of maintenance. Stated that they have discussed this with DOT. If the town perceives that it is not a town road then they would have to reimburse the state for their reimbursements over the years. Bob stated that he will bring this up at a future Selectmen's Meeting for a vote on putting it on the warrant for the annual town meeting. Paul stated that he believes that an error was made and it was inadvertently left off a warrant for acceptance as a town road years back when they accepted a large number of roads.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Willis explained that he has contacted Fritz and Casella for prices on hauling the tires from the Transfer Station. Fritz quoted \$1.70 per passenger tire which includes loading and hauling. Charge \$8 - \$9 each for truck tires. Casella charges \$200 per load for transportation and we have to load them as well as per tire charges. Stated that if you can put truck tires in the Transfer Station it would only cost \$5.88 each which would be much less expensive. Motion by Willis to start charging for truck tires and seconded by Bob. Vote 2-0-0.

Motion by Willis and seconded by Bob to accept the minutes of 2/5/02 as written. Vote 2-0-0.

Willis reviewed the list of upcoming meetings.

Willis and seconded by Bob to adjourn at 9:10 p.m. Vote 2-0-0.
