

**Transfer Station & Recycling Facility  
Committee Meeting  
8/24/06**

The meeting was opened at 7 PM by chairman Paul Kussman, other present were: Willis Lord, Evan Grover, Bob Fay, Ralph & Barbara Bowley, Paul Verrill, Clinton Andrews, and Charlie Brown and Owen McCullough from Sebago Techniques.

Charlie and Owen discussed the drainage system design for the facility. They are looking into eliminating the expensive underground drainage and will contact the DEP and have them consider changing the plan using only small sediment ponds and drainage manholes. They will get back to us as soon as they have an answer from DEP.

The committee wants all former committee members contacted to see if any of them would consider being reappointed.

Clint will prepare a three month comparison for HHW showing the total for each month.

Paul V. motioned and Ralph Bowley seconded that we promote recycling at the transfer station and use any tool available through ECO Maine; especially the programs available using Missi Labbe and Reggie the raccoon for the elementary grades. Paul K. will speak with the superintendent to see what arrangements are needed. They also voted to spot light local businesses that make an effort toward increasing recycling

Single stream recycling will be discussed further at the next ECO Maine meeting and that information will be discussed at our next meeting, Paul K. will contact ECO and see if we can have a representative come out and explain the program in more detail.

Electronics storage trailer - Clint will speak with Bob Jones about the trailer that has been offered for electronic storage and about moving it into place.

Electric - Clint has met with C.M.P. and Tom Roberge, the electrician, and developed a plan for both overhead and underground lighting. He will give quotes on us owning the poles, a new 400 amp service behind the existing office, 2 - 100 amp services and complete mast systems, one for the recycling building and one for the new office. One plug and switch for a mercury vapor lights, one inside and one outside, the recycling building and a set of motion spot lights on the back of the building.

The new office will have 10 plugs and overhead lighting and exterior lighting roadside and by the door and 2 sets of motion spot lights. All hookups from the pole to the buildings will be quoted for both overhead and under ground. Evan has also been talking with both CMP and Roberge.

Stickers are slowing down we have given out about 2,500 to date. Very few do not have a sticker.

Clint reported that he has talked with a representative of the Hollis Committee and they would like to meet with us to discuss proposals for fees for use of our facility as in the past. Paul K., Willis, Evan, and Clint were put on a committee to investigate this. Clint will write a letter to arrange a joint meeting

Clint will draw a plan showing the location for the new building, roads showing the traffic pattern, and a possible location for future septic and water.

Clint will meet with Nancy to go over budget issues.

Clint met with Nancy and Atlantic leasing to go over the condition of the HHW compactor. Dwayne and Willis were also present. The compactor is in very serious condition needs to have the rams re-chromed and packed and even then the compactor will not meet OSHA standards.

A 3 month report showing income and expenses will be completed by Clint and will be for the first quarter, July, August and September; this report will be ready for the October meeting.

Next meeting will be September 14, 2006 at 7 PM. Meeting adjourned
