The minutes from the March 5, 2007 meeting were approved by a motion made by Brigit and seconded and approved 5 to 0.

Clint created a Waterboro Recycles flyer that will be in the Reporter this week

Brigit is working with Saco River Television to help promote recycling. Brigit will also be meeting with Superintendent of schools Linda Greene and Missy from Ecomaine.

The committee will have a booth on voting day and during town meeting. Clint suggested giving away a basket with a couple compact fluorescent light bulbs. Evan suggested he might be able to get some of those light bulbs for free.

A suggestion was made about having banners made and put in various areas in town saying "Waterboro Recycles items 1-7". It was also suggested to have the Reporter and Smart Shopper run little ads weekly that say "Waterboro Recycles Paper", etc.

Brigit will be creating a flyer that can be mailed with the town warrant.

It was brought to the committee's attention that the town's website does not have current information on what the town recycles. Evan and Don will be working on getting the town website current and more user friendly.

A discussion was had about all the signs for businesses and churches there are in Waterboro. It was suggested that we ask those business owners and churches to put an advertisement about recycling on those signs. A suggestion was made in connection with Earth Week April 22<sup>nd</sup> that the committee sponsor a recycling sign contest have the contest run through to Old Home Days.

Don will work with the Ossipee Lake Association for the boat parade.

Clint reported that by compacting 4 loads of plastic, tin cans, aluminum foil, glass, etc. into 1 compacted load had a savings in tipping fees of \$315.00

Clint reported that the returnables that are collected at the Transfer Station and donated to the Waterboro fuel assistance program collected to date approximately \$600.00.

The next Transfer Station meeting will be held April 2, 2007 at 7:00 PM
