

**Transfer Station**  
**March 3, 2008**  
**7:00 PM**

Members present: Chairman, David Woodsome, Brigit McCallum, Evan Grover, Willis Lord, Karen Banks, Don Holden, Dennis Abbott, Committee Secretary, Nancy Roberge, Clint Andrews.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM.

Motion by Brigit to approve the February 2, 2008 meeting minutes and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen and approved 6-0 with amendments.

Brigit reported to the Committee that there are boxes at all the schools and library for recycling for DVD's, CD's and cases. A 55 gallon barrel could be added at the Transfer Station to accept these items. Brigit will look more into the recycling and possibly research someone sponsoring the shipping. Motion by Karen and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Brigit to start recycling DVD's , CD's & cases approved 5-0.

Brigit also reported that she was approached by someone in the Jr. High regarding Adopt a Highway. It was asked if this could possibly be reconsidered? Brigit will get more details and go before the Board of Selectmen.

Brigit will also do the research of someone possibly sponsoring/buying/donating recycling bins for the schools.

Antifreeze Tank: No status change.

Karen had several ideas for Earth Day April 22, 2008.

- Phone book drive/contest
- Art contest (Brigit & Karen to work on)

Evan & Karen reported that the trash bins at the cluster boxes in Lake Arrowhead are filled with catalogs and mail that are probably dumped in the household waste at the Transfer Station. Could possibly put boxes there for the recycling of CD's, DVD's & cases.

Job Descriptions were passed out by Clint and discussed in detail along with the 5 year Capital Plan.

Trash Bags: There was a suggestion that the Transfer Station sell these bags and the money go towards fuel assistance.

Compost Pile: No charge this year, but a limit of 1 yard per household by a motion by Brigit and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen and approved 6-0.

Compost Bins: We are not going to offer these with other towns.

Willis reported that EcoMaine is running short on materials.

Karen reported that on the Town website, most of the links do not work and there is nothing on them.

The next meeting will be held April 7, 2008 at 7:00 PM.
