

**Transfer Station Committee**  
**Workshop**  
**September 8, 2008**  
**7:00 PM**

Members present: Chairman David Woodsome, Karen Banks, Willis Lord, Dennis Abbott, Committee Secretary Nancy Roberge, Clint Andrews, Fred Fay.

Meeting called to order at 7:15 PM.

There was a discussion regarding the silver bullets and Clint distributed the EcoMaine Terms and Conditions. Two to three years ago, EcoMaine Attorneys promised to give us a boilerplate licensing agreement and ordinance for commercial trash haulers. As of this date, we have not received anything from EcoMaine. It was suggested that the town should request a meeting with the Representatives from EcoMaine.

SAD 57: We need to have a meeting with the Superintendent. It was mentioned that Dean Waterhouse has approached the school system to make a deal with them on there cardboard and put a container at the High School for a monthly fee and he would haul it away.

Cardboard: Six months ago the beer companies started picking up the cardboard at JD's and we lost the cardboard and now we only get the household waste. We need an ordinance in place when new businesses come in all trash and recyclables come to the Transfer Station.

Clint distributed the capital improvements completed at the Transfer Station and the fiscal year report and a quote on a reconditioned compactor. The Committee recommended putting the compactor and the concrete work out to bid. Clint will talk with Nancy Brandt to contact Charlie Brown to draw up a sketch for the concrete work as soon as possible.

Clint reported that he found a company that will pay us \$.60 per gallon for waste oil. Clint estimated that we get approximately 3,000 gallons per year.

The next meeting is October 6, 2008 at 7:00 PM.
