Silver Bullets: To be placed at the fire station, Lions Club and Town Hall. We need to check into placing them at Lakeside Market and Plummers Hardware.

Recycling Containers at the School: Dennis to follow-up with a letter.

Recycling:

- Clint & Brigit to do taping for a video for a public service announcement.
- Some ideas to promote recycling: Phone, mass mailings, T-Group surveys & possibly start with WAB & senior citizens group.
- Where do we want to be 5 years from now? Do we want to include in that plan now to reduce carbon footprint?
- Jon's suggestion: Example: 40 gallon bag of HHW @ \$1.50 each and 1 container of recyclables will get 1 free 40 gallon bag or sticker for next dump visit. One drawback, if people use the silver bullets they cannot get a free bag.
- A Subcommittee with members Clint, David W. & Dennis formed to consider all the options and they will meet on October 19th.

Hollis Renewal: If they are interested, Hollis needs to contact Waterboro.

It was brought to the Committee's attention that JD's is dumping cardboard and recyclables into the household waste compactor.

The Town of Waterboro Solid Waste Disposal & Control Ordinance was distributed out to the Committee. Everyone will review and suggest changes for the 10/26/09 meeting.
