

**Transfer Station Committee
Meeting**

March 28,2011

Members present: Pat Aureli, Bob Gobeil, Lucas Beaubien, Frank Allen, David Woodsome, Clint Andrews and Committee Secretary Nancy Roberge.

Meeting called to order at 6:05 PM.

Motion by Bob and 2nd by Frank to approve the February 15, 2011 meeting minutes, approved 4-0.

Earth Day:

Earth Day is April 22, 2011 and to celebrate we will be having the ribbon cutting ceremony of the new recycling compactor at the Transfer Station at 10:00 AM.

Clint received an email from the State Recycling Program that his application was accepted for a grant for a sign. Clint to talk to the Code Enforcement Officer to see if we need a permit for the sign. The deadline is June 30, 2011. Clint will inform RSD Graphics that we need the sign completed before Earth Day.

Motion by Frank and 2nd by Bob to purchase ribbon & scissors for the official ribbon cutting ceremony, approved 4-0. It was then suggested that we not spend money on ribbon since we are trying to promote recycling, the ribbon should be made out of recycled materials. Committee Secretary offered to make a ribbon out of recycled paper.

Frank will invite Tammy Welsh to the ceremony. Clint will invite the Selectmen. On 4/22/11 at the Transfer Station the recycling flyers will be handed out and the composter bins and rain buckets will be displayed.

Clint informed the committee that the Town of Dayton wants to use the Transfer Station for recycling and pay to dispose items (no HHW). There will be a workshop with the Selectmen on 3/29/11 to discuss this issue. If we allow Dayton & Hollis to use our facility, they should be charged a fixed amount of money person. Roughly it costs approx. \$93.00 per person to dispose of HHW and approx. \$18.21 per person for recycling.

The next meeting is scheduled on 4/25/11 at 6:00 PM.

Motion by Bob and 2nd by Lucas to adjourn at 8:00 PM. Approved 5-0.
