

Transfer Station Meeting
11/28/11
6:30 PM

Members present: Pat Aureli, Bob Gobeil, Lucas Beaubien, Frank Allen, Dennis Abbott and Committee Secretary, Nancy Roberge. Also present: Clint Andrews and David Pope from MMS.

Meeting called to order at 6:40 PM.

Motion to approve the minutes from October 24, 2011 by Lucas 2nd by Pat approved 3-0.

Zero Waste:

3 days of collecting just at lunch time they collected 629 pounds at MMS. Of that 31% of that was compost, 6.7% was plastic silverware, 31.3% was compost, 16.8% was recyclables, 18% was liquids, 27.2% was trash. David reported that there is a system that he and his students are checking into and they would like to apply for a grant for this project.

Lucas indicated that Cyro Industries in Sanford, Maine has a system that recycles and once a year they clean it out and it becomes compost.

No dumping signage: Clint has the signs but they have not been put up yet. Pat will email the Road Commissioner to see if he will put them up.

Committee budgets are due in December. Clint was not sure if they were due before Christmas or after Christmas.

Nancy presented to the Committee the suggestion from the Road Review Committee to split the purchase of a laptop for the use of the Committee Secretary for Road Review Committee and Transfer Station Committee meetings. The Road Review Committee has put it into their budget and the Transfer Station Committee will be submitting in our budget as well

Commercial Haulers Liability Insurance:

Clint will ask Nancy Brandt what needs to be done to change the Ordinances to add that Commercial Haulers need to provide the Town with a Certificate of Insurance & Certificate of Liability.

Committee recommendation for the Town of Hollis & Use of the Transfer Station for recycling:

Motion by Frank that the Town of Hollis needs to come up with a better proposal 2nd by Lucas and approved 3-0.

Residential Household Hazardous Waste:

Frank checked into it and it is handled on a contractual basis and can cost anywhere from \$0 - \$15,000.00.

Nancy to find out from DEP (State Planning Office) when is the next hazardous waste clean up day.

Lucas will check into a company that may take tires for free for recycling.

Motion by Lucas 2nd by Bob to have our December 19th as a planning meeting and to purchase pizza and soda for the meeting to be paid for by the Committee budget.. Approved 3-0.

The next meeting will be December 19, 2011 at 6:30 PM

Motion to adjourn at 8:30 PM by Lucas 2nd Bob approved 3-0.
